

Installation - Presets for LuSH-101

Location of the presets:

By default, presets are kept on the hard drive:

- for MacOS – the folder "[user_name]/Application Support/D16 Group/LuSH-101"
- for Windows – the folder "c:\Users\[user_name]\AppData\Roaming\D16 Group\LuSH-101"

Lush is quite flexible with regard to its presets location, but it can make it confusing, so please read carefully the following, there are a few ways presets can be managed in Lush and therefore a few ways in which you can add presets:

1) Using the structure already built in to the factory bank. Presets are divided into Single Zone and Mutli Zone with many further sub divisions.
Example: D16 Group\LuSH-101\Presets\Single Zone etc

If you would like to make use of this structure, then simply copy the contents of each sub folder from the Flight Path soundbank "presets" folder to your Lush-101 "presets" folder. I have organized all my presets in the same way the factory content is organized, making it easy for you to add this soundbank to your factory sounds.

2) You can have a new and separate folder along side your normal factory bank. I have prepared my own folder with my own categories, which you might find more familiar (lead, pluck, pad etc). Open "Alternative Folder Styles" and inside it you will see "Flight Path". Now you may place "Flight Path" right into Lush's Presets folder. It would look like this:

D16 Group\LuSH-101\Presets\Flight Path

With this method, you could keep all of the new soundbank sounds separate so you can easily explore what you have just bought.

3) If you just want all the preset files so you can place them somewhere you choose, just open the folder "Just Presets" and you will find them all there.

Finally, there are also Delay and Reverb Presets in their respective folders. These can easily be copied to their counterparts in the factory folders of Lush-101
